- OIG authorized and funded in FY 2016 Omnibus
- Two divisions: Investigations and Audits
- Reports to Head of Agency (Chairperson) and Congress






OIG Timeline

- Strategic Horizon: 3 Years from FY 2016
Omnibus appropriation for OIG
 - Establish senior staff, assess needs and risks (6 mos.)
 - Establish infrastructure, policies; take cases (7-12 mos.)
 - Evaluate and report to Chairperson (20-24 mos.)
 - Assess capacity and performance (30-36 mos.)
 - Fully Mission Capable / Final OIG Structure in FY 2019
